Roadworks

The construction crew are currently reconstructing the last 4.8km section of M040 from Echo Valley Road heading West to Rabbit Proof Fence Road. This will involve

Widening of the basecourse to 10m with a new 7.5m 2 coat bitumen seal.

New Roadtrain Sidetippers

The Council have taken possession of their new set of Howard Porter roadtrain sidetippers which, with their existing roadtrain will improve the output of gravel cartage for road construction projects as well as give the Council greater opportunity to source sub-contract private works within the area.

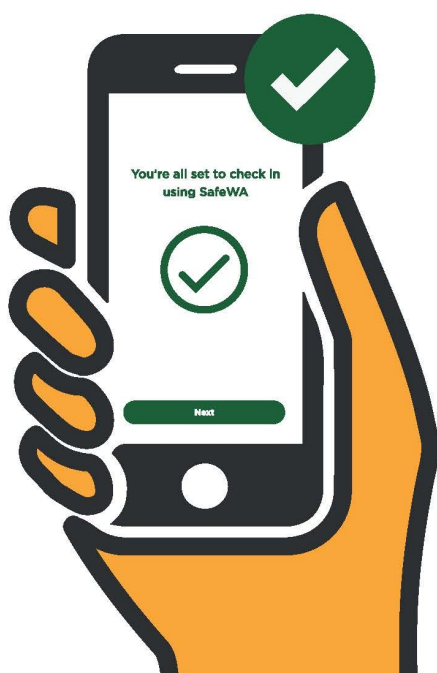
