FIRE BREAKS ORDER

Fire Breaks Order

Council has responsibilities under the *Bush Fires Act 1954* to ensure that landowners have cleared fire breaks and removed flammable materials from their land according to the instructions outlined in the Shire's annual Fire Break Orders.

The requirements of the Orders are considered the minimum standard for fire prevention not only to protect individual properties but the district in general.

The requirements of the Orders are in addition to and do not detract from any other requirement under any other written law or legislation.

Fire Break Orders will be distributed with the annual rates notices to rate payers which will occur in July 2021

All rate payers are reminded NOT TO THROW AWAY there Fire Break Orders. Rate payers should keep the Orders in a safe place and ensure that they review the Orders to see what requirements are necessary to ensure their property is adequately prepared for the bushfire season which will commence from 1 November 2021.

All rate payers should note that where their property has been found to be in breach of the requirements of the Fire Break Orders (inspections are carried out by the Shire annually) then they may be issued an infringement.

Museum Upgrades

Works have recently been completed on the ramp and parking areas at the rear on the Museum



Work has steadily been progressing on the Westonia Caravan Park Upgrades.

An additional 6 bays have been included utilizing a herring bone formation to assist reversing with new concrete pads.

New electrical bollards and waste plumbing have been installed as well as a new hot mixed driveway, landscaping and fencing the surrounds.

Still to be installed is brushwood fencing on the Mine Camp boundary and lawn to the camping area in the warmer months.

The Shire of Westonia has made tourism a major focus of its recent capital works with the current works made possible the Federal by Governments Local Roads and Community Infrastructure (LRCI) Program -Phase 1 which included installing toilets and flushing shade Baladije to and areas Elachbutting Rocks.
