DFES BUSHFIRE TRAINING

BFS Bush Fire Fighter Course

With significant changes to WHS Act the Executive of Council have an increased burden for the Health and Safety of its Bushfire Volunteers. Hence Council are endorsing a policy that strongly encourages mandatory minimal training to remain as a volunteer with a brigade and to enter the fire ground.

DFES Training has been organised as following.

Monday 20th & Tuesday 21st March 2023 - Individual 1-day Courses (usually 2-Day Course) for experienced volunteers to gain BFS Bush Fire Fighter accreditation.

Wednesday 22nd & Thursday 23rd March 2023 2-Day Course for new inexperienced volunteers to gain BFS Bush Fire Fighter accreditation.

Frequent reminders will be sent out in the New Year encouraging your participation.

- Since the takeover of the CRC has seen plenty of changes with the new service delivery focus being centered on Health & Wellbeing initiatives as well as 2 x community events held annually. With the appointment of Stacey as Manager Community Development and Emilie as Wellbeing Officer inroads are being made on Council's application as a Home Aged Care Service Provider (HACC). Planning is also underway for the redevelopment of the Westonia Primary School as a permanent Seniors Activity Centre.
- Council has worked diligently on securing permanent funding for the Nurse Practitioner clinic which is held on a weekly basis.
- Special mention to Mr Robert Murray from Walgoolan who has volunteered a significant amount of his time to restore the old Walgoolan Wagon which will be on display in a new shelter adjacent to the history gazebo in the truck bay.
- Exciting times ahead with the proposed redevelopment of the Diorite Street Recreation Precinct which will see the construction of a new Bowls shelter over an expanded 6 rink playing area. Designs are nearly completed for the construction of a new Pool kiosk and ablution facility at the pool.

Luckily we had a willing Councilor in attendance who thanked, everyone for joining the celebration, the Westonia Tavern for their efforts, the Shire for putting it together and wished all who attended a Merry Christmas and Happy New Year Thank you to all who attended. 

LAST ROAD TRIP FOR 2022


