#### Initial Survey – Westonia RAC Streetscape Project

Council previously endorsed an application to the RAC's Reconnect WA Initiative in 2022-23, providing up to \$1 million to co-fund projects and partner with local governments across WA.

Council were keen to continue with streetscape enhancements to compliment the already impressive Facades and features enjoyed by the community and visitors to the town.

Over the past few weeks Council has conducted a surveymonkey on the Wolfram Streetscape Improvements Project/Survey and receive the following feedback from the community on these areas.

Please see below Survey results

- > Seating and shade were popularly requested in the survey.
- > The most popular historic Westonian businesses selected for use on the little shops in descending order were the Pioneer Bakery, the Edna May Dairy, the Edna May Laundry, the SE Stubber Family Butcher and the Nurse Petterson Maternity Home (both polled exactly the same at 46.15%, see Little Shop themes below). As we are only doing 4 little shops, it is recommended that the Nurse Petterson Maternity Home is used due to the uniqueness of this early Westonian business rather than the SE Stubber Family Butcher on this occasion.
- > There was no standout winner on the preferred theme for the art mural on the small shop

next to the Coop, with 38.46% of respondents selecting the Westonia Agencies Hardware theme and exactly the same percentage (38.46%) selecting the Westonia's First Post Office theme, with the remaining 23.08% preferring a different theme (see Art Mural on the Small Shop next to the Coop). As the Westonia Agencies Hardware theme is more closely related to this part of the main street, this theme is possibly more appropriate. However, as the First Post Office is an interesting historical story in itself and as suggested by a community member, perhaps something else could be done to showcase the contrast between the current post office and what the town began with.

> The most popular orchids selected for an orchid theme on the Coop windows (which was selected by 53.8% of respondents) in descending order were the Donkey Orchid, the Jack in the Box Orchid, and then the Spider Orchid, Blue Fairy Orchid and Sugar Candy Orchid (the last 3 orchids all polled the same at 50%, see Art for the 3 Coop Windows below). As the Blue Fairy Orchid was used on the art mural

> painted on Mukinbudin's main street, it was recommended that the artist use the Donkey Orchid, the Jack in the Box Orchid and the Sugar Candy Orchid.

> These and other improvements will continue to be upgraded to make our town even better.
