





1	Home alarm and/or CCTV systems (minimum purchase/installation value of \$200)	\$400 Note: if this item is installed by a contractor, the contractor must be a licenced Security Agent and Security Installer.
2	Security door screens (minimum purchase/installation value of \$200)	\$400 Note: if this item is installed by a contractor, the contractor must be a licenced Security Agent and Security Installer.
3	Deadlock (door or window) (minimum purchase/installation value of \$50)	Maximum rebate claim of \$200 for each deadlock Note: if this item is installed by a contractor, the contractor must be a licenced Security Agent and Security Installer.
4	Security window screen or window shutters (minimum purchase value/installation of \$100)	\$400


