



Roadworks

The construction crew have completed a 2km section of DellaBosca Road which included a gravel re-sheet and drainage improvements.

Winter grading has not been that productive to date due to the dry weather conditions. The following roads have had some attention though being Rabbit Proof Fence North, Elsewhere, Maisefield, Jones, Hobbs, section of Elachbutting in the northern part of the shire and Lindley, Waddell and section of Maxfield in the central part.

Standpipes

The McPharlin Road standpipe upgrade has been completed with the installation of 2 x 30,000L tanks and associated plumbing being completed



Additional upgrades are being carried out at Warralakin and Boodarockin sites.





Phase 3 commencing Saturday 6 June 2020

The State Government has implemented a staged lifting of COVID-19 restrictions and developed guidelines to assist businesses and community activities to reopen, recommence or expand activities.

Under Phase 3 Easing of Restrictions, Local Governments may be able to increase their operational or activity's capacity, which should be reflected in their updated COVID Safety Plan and Certificate.

- Wanderers Stadium (including Bowls & Tennis courts)
- Old School Sewing room

In Addition, previous restrictions on the following have also been eased:

- Camping facilities at all Rocks & Reserves within the Shire.
- Westonia Caravan Park
- 48hr Free Camp @ St Lukes Church

At this stage the Westonia 24hr Gym and the Caravan Park overflow is still closed at the complex

The safety of our staff and patrons is our first priority and we appreciate your understanding in these uncertain times.

We are attempting to stay on top of the COVID 19 situation by following guidelines from the WA Department

of Health and our peak industry bodies. Recent announcements from the Department of Premier & Cabinet has allowed Community facilities such as Recreation Centres, youth centres or senior citizens centres were permitted to open with restrictions. Therefore the Westonia Recreation Centre (Complex) is open BY APPOINTMENT ONLY for fitness classes or small group training up to a maximum of 20 participants and there is 4 square metres of floor space per person, up to a maximum of 20 participants in total at the venue.

Equipment is not allowed to be shared in a session. It must be cleaned between every session.

This means you cannot use any gym machines, like Pilates reformers, weight machines, exercise bicycles, rowing machines, and treadmills.
