Cemetery

Roadworks

The bulk of the roads crew have concentrated their efforts on winter grading roads whilst conditions are good.

The gang are currently on Echo Valley Road heading North to complete the roads in the far north of the shire.

Trucks have continued to cart gravel on construction jobs and have recently completed a 2Km section of Boodarockin Road.

Recycling
