The new Caretaker office for the Caravan Park is complete. The Shire purchased a second hand office Donga as a permanent office building/residence for the caravan park caretaker. The building came with an existing Kitchenette, Reverse Cycle airconditioning and various appliances. Power and water were connected and minor plumbing was done for the grey water.

Local builders Hilo & Centek constructions have made various modifications. A dividing wall and door have been added, to box off one end for a bedroom and the remainder kitchen/lounge/ office. A Deck has been added to the front of the building for access. The New caretaker office is a welcome addition to the caravan park for the caretaker and visitors alike. Caretakers no longer have to operate out of their own van and Visitors are easily able to identify the building when checking in or out. Funding was also obtained via the Hon. Melissa Price through the Stronger Communities Programme to the value of \$13,750 to go towards the project.

Carrabin Rail Paltform

After over Forty (40) years of letter writing and persistence, the works on the new Carrabin Rail Platform is finally complete and fully operational. To celebrate, the Westonia CRC recently organised a trip on the train to Northam for lunch and a spot of window shopping which was attended by 24 seniors and CRC Staff with the new platform a resounding success with our Seniors. The new ramp access ensures no more climbing up stairs to board the train.

Work to upgrade Carrabin Station on Transwa's Prospector route is now complete, and services began operating from the new station on Monday December 17, 2018 . The new Carrabin Station is located on the northern side of the rail line, 650m east of the old station, and is fully compliant with Disability and Discrimination Act (DDA) standards.



The project included:

A new raised platform which will be sheltered, accessible via ramp or stairs, and have seating for three people;

A new station access road off Carrabin Siding Road, with a bus turning circle, bus shelter, and vehicle access ramp;

One car bay and one ACROD bay, line marking and bollards, new kerbing and bitumen surface;

Station lighting and signage.

The new station will improve the experience of Transwa passengers travelling to or from Carrabin Station on the Prospector service, which operates at least once daily between Kalgoorlie and East Perth.

Removal of the old station and pedestrian level crossing will take place in early 2019.

The Westonia Golf Club were recently successful in obtaining a grant to upgrade the Golf Clubhouse facility.

A total of \$49,500 plus GST was granted via the Federal Government's Sport Australia's Move It Aus - Community Sport Infrastructure grant program.

The Golf Club is now in its 46 year and is starting to show. The upgrades will include:

- A small extension to the rear of the building for additional storage;
- Upgrades to the ceiling (removing the egg cartons and replacing with an aesthetically pleasing alternative);
- New carpets;
- Small kitchen upgrade;
- Interior Paint; andVeranda upgrade



The proposed upgrades will allow the building to enter the 21st Century in terms of appearance, functionality and will lend itself to be used for a variety of functions. Works are expected to commence in the next couple of months.
