## **FUEL STATION**

The Westonia Progress Association (WPA) Fuel Station, after some initial delays is progressing well with the recent installation of the 30,000L underground tank. It has 20,000L Diesel and 10,000L PULP compartments.

Next week will see the installation of piping so the remainder of the site can be backfilled in preparation for concrete hardstand work.

New bowser, OPT, lighting and signage will complete the project over the next month or so.



## **BOWLING GREEN INSTALLATION**

Finally the bowling green installation will commence in the next fortnight. Council has taken delivery of the rolls of synthetic grass and sand fill with initial works for the limestone retaining walls about to commence.



## STREETSCAPE

Signage has been installed on the small shop which is depicting the Old Westonia Agencies Façade. The 4 small shops have now been completed and the shelters being located in front of the Old Miners Hall will be completed in the next 2 weeks.


