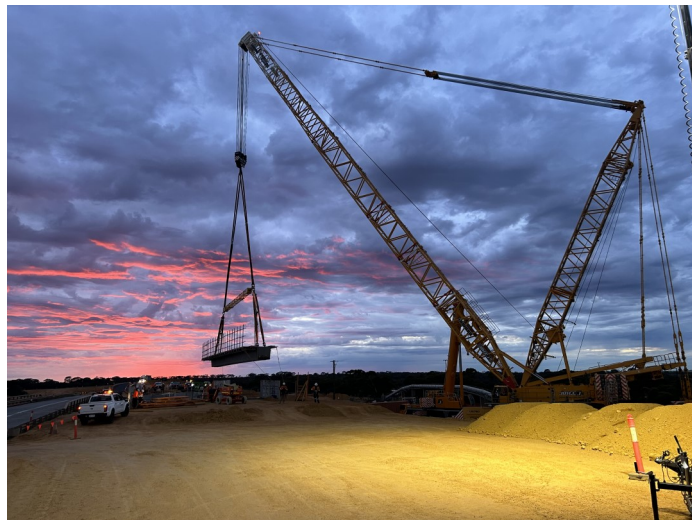
GREAT EASTERN HIGHWAY UPDATE

We have received some much wanted statistics regarding the Walgoolan Bridge Replacement.

Crane Assembly, 350T put the 750T Crane together which required 17 road trains (30 trailers in total) worth of equipment – i.e counterweights etc.

The 750T Crane did the lifting of the beams in place. 4 Beams in total which weigh 100T each, lifts were done over 3 days making use of pre-planned breaks in the Rail Schedule, with safety measures in place. Beams are delivered on Jinkers (which are adjustable trailers) Beams are cast in Herne Hill. 33M long single span beams/bridge which allows for any future Rail Duplication. Deck and Barriers to begin shortly approx. 20T of Steel and 250T of Concrete.

Project completion approx. December 2023. Total works will be 3km of new alignment (2km of which is operational) and upgrade of Warralakin Road.

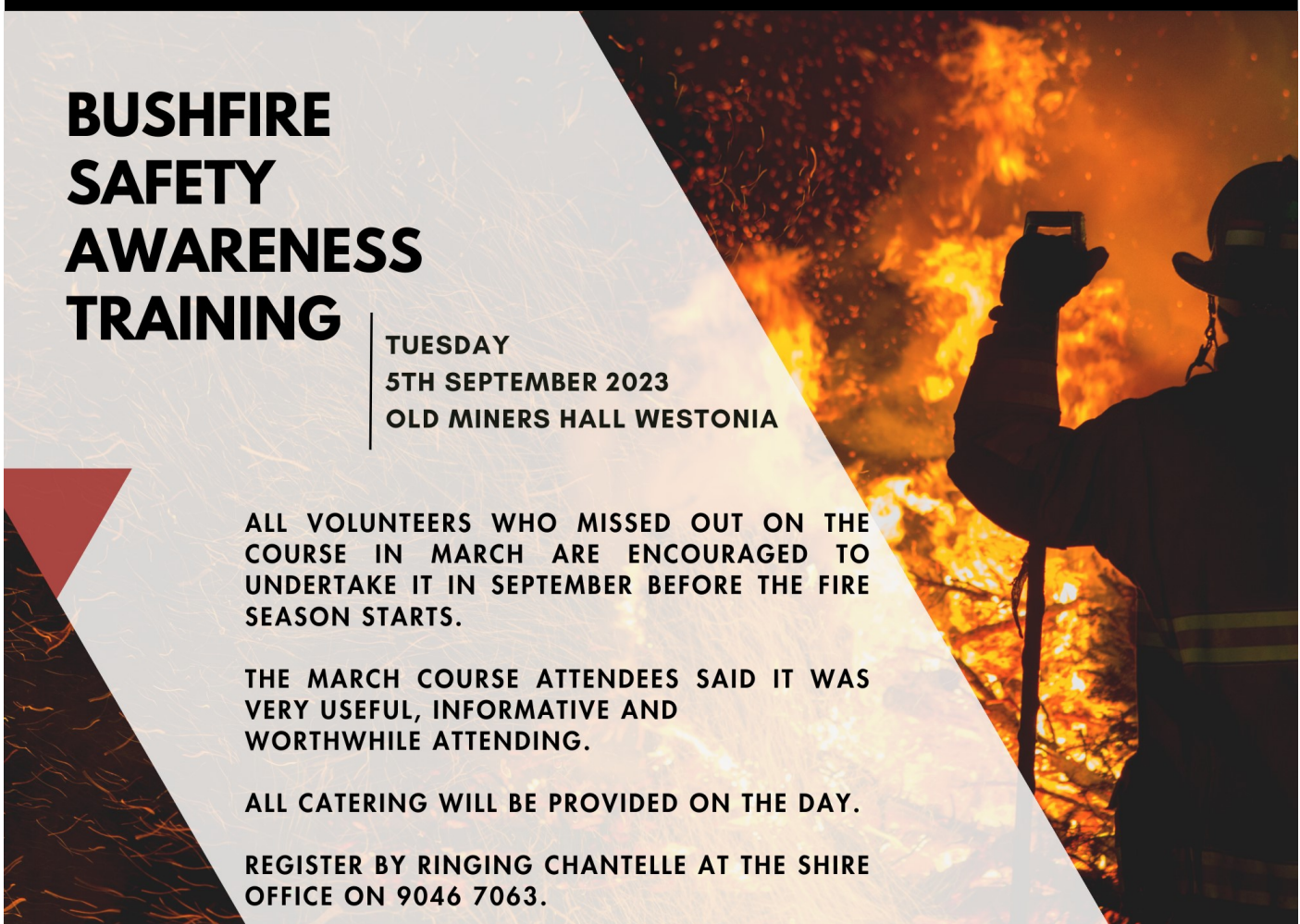

LOCAL GOVERNMENT ORDINARY ELECTIONS**CLOSE OF ENROLMENTS****ROLL CLOSE: 5.00pm FRIDAY, August 25, 2023**

You may be eligible to be enrolled to vote in the following in-person Local Government elections on 21 October 2023 if you live in or are an owner or occupier of rateable property in the Shire of Westonia.

Residents

You are automatically enrolled to vote if you are on the State Electoral Roll as at 5.00pm 25 August 2023. If you are not already on the State Electoral Roll but meet the eligibility criteria for this roll, a claim for enrolment can be made to any Divisional Returning Officer of the Australian Electoral Commission in Western Australia. Forms are available from all post offices or the Western Australian Electoral Commission and must be completed and reach a Divisional Returning Officer by 5.00pm Friday 25 August 2023.

Non-Resident Owners and Occupiers

If you are a non-resident owner or occupier of rateable property in your Local Government area and are on the State or Commonwealth Electoral Roll, you are eligible to enrol to vote and should make an enrolment application to the Local Government. If you are not on the State or Commonwealth Electoral Roll and own or occupy rateable property in a particular Local Government, you may be eligible to enrol to vote if you were on the Local Government's last electoral roll prior to May 1997. Please contact the particular Local Government for details. Owners of land who were on the last roll of the Local Government continue to retain that

status until they cease to own the rateable property to which the enrolment relates. Occupiers do not have continuous enrolment and should contact their particular Local Government to confirm their enrolment status. To be eligible to enrol as an occupier, you will need to have a right of continuous occupation under a lease, tenancy agreement or other legal instrument for at least the next 3 months following the date of the application to enrol.

Joint Owners and Occupiers

If a rateable property is owned or occupied by more than two people, a majority of the owners/occupiers may nominate two persons from amongst themselves who are on either the State or Commonwealth Electoral Roll, to enrol as owner/occupier electors.

Corporations

A body corporate that owns, or occupies rateable property may nominate two people who are on either the State or Commonwealth Electoral Roll to enrol as owner/occupier electors.

Enrolment Forms

Enrolment claim forms can be obtained from the Shire of Westonia, all Post Offices or Australian Electoral Commission offices and should be lodged with the Chief Executive Officer by 5.00pm Friday 25 August 2023. Further information can be obtained from the Shire of Westonia.
