



WARRALAKIN TANK RESTORATION PROJECT

Stage 2 of the restoration works has been completed with the application of a concrete treatment to seal any weepage points and cracks. The Hexa floating Cover material arrives onsite this week prior to its planned installation during the second week of December. At the completion of this works Council will reinstate the catchment wall to allow water to flow back into the tank.



POOL KIOSK

Counting down to the completion of this very exciting project. The building is blending in extremely well with the existing stadium buildings and is anticipated to be completed prior to Christmas, minus a bit of landscaping which will be completed when the weather cools down.

The vinyl floor coverings have been installed with only the fitout, final painting and electrical to be completed internally. On the outside will see concrete footpaths and surrounding areas, install of a BBQ and patio, security fencing and a chemical storage shed to be completed.

AUTOMATIC DOOR AT HEALTH CLINIC

The new automatic door has been installed at the Health Clinic which completes the entry upgrade to the building apart from a bit of asphalt work.

Share what living in the Wheatbelt is like with doctors of the future

One hundred medical students will be coming to the Wheatbelt in March 2025. During their stay, they will visit local farms, industry, general practices, hospitals and schools, and participate in community activities.

We need you to provide real-life experiences that will give them an understanding of what it is like to live in the Wheatbelt and perhaps inspire them to become rural doctors.

The students will visit the following towns:

- Bruce Rock
- Cunderdin
- Kellerberrin
- Merredin
- Narrogin
- Southern Cross
- Tammin
- Westonia

As a host, we will ask you to provide accommodation for two or three students, to assist with transporting them to/from town, and share what it is like to live in your town with the students. You are invited to come along to a Thank You Dinner with the students on the Thursday night.

Why host?

This is a life-changing experience for the students, with many having no previous exposure to rural life or the Wheatbelt. By providing these rural immersion opportunities early in their degree, it has been proven that students are:

- more likely to explore rural career opportunities; and
- better able to provide patient-centred care to rural people.

Some students, who have previously been hosted through this program, continue to keep in touch and visit their host families, some return to do seasonal work and placements, others have joined mentoring programs, some have inspired host family members to pursue tertiary studies in health and medicine, and numerous students are now doctors in the Wheatbelt and other parts of rural/remote WA and Australia.
