


farm for the students to cook dinner and it was enjoyed by all!


RAMELIUS MINE CLOSURE

As you are all aware the mining operations at the Edna May Mine site is nearing a care and maintenance period after a 16 years. The Council and Ramelius management have been in negotiations for the last 12 months on an exit strategy which has involved addressing areas such as;

- Lease agreement extensions on the camp,
 Industrial Shed and carpark areas.
- Conversion of the WWTP to accommodate the Caravan Park and house effluent.
- Contribution towards a mining display at the Museum
- Demolition and clean up of the old farm house site on the corner Warrachuppin and Settineri Roads
- Negotiation for lease land for the use by Westonia Progress Association for future cropping purposes.
- Handover of housing assets
- Farewell/Celebration Dinner

This is an opportunity for the Council on behalf of the community and local business to extend their appreciation to Ramelius and those involved in the Mining operations as the place will be a lot quieter without all of the activity of the past. Your legacy will form part of Westonia's history forever.

The community may be aware that Westonia currently does not have their St Johns Ambulance parked locally as we do not have any volunteers since the retirement of Karin & Rohan Day.

We are still serviced by the St John Ambulance sub centre of Southern Cross and Merredin but there is obviously a time delay in response. Council believe that this is really unacceptable

Council at its February meeting have resolved that we advertise an Expression of Interest (EOI) for a practicing and/or retiring health professional who may be able to fill this void. Subsidised housing, monetary retention payment and other incentives are being offered. The Council intend to hold a public meeting with the community to discuss the outcome of the EOI as well as the different options of funding this position which is likely to include contributions from the Council, Westonia Progress Association, Corporate sponsorship and individual community memberships.

A recruitment drive will also be initiated to get more volunteers to assist with the operation of the ambulance.


