Nominations must be lodged with the Returning Officer at any time during the above period at the offices of the Shire of Westonia, 41 Wolfram Street, WESTONIA.

### **Nominations Requirements**

Candidates are required to lodge with the Returning Officer:

- a completed nomination in the prescribed form, signed and witnessed. This form is available from the Shire of Westonia.
- a single A4 page profile of not more than 1,000 characters (including spaces) containing information about the candidate and statements of the candidate's policies or beliefs;
- a nomination deposit of \$100 (cash, EFT, bank cheque or postal order);
- a recent passport-sized photograph (optional); and
- (optional) in addition to your A4 profile, you may provide additional information that you
  consider to be relevant to your candidature. This written statement must be not more
  than 2,000 characters (including spaces), must be in the English language and is for
  publication on the local government's official website.

To nominate, every individual must complete the mandatory induction for prospective candidates course, available from the Department of Local Government, Industry Regulation and Safety via the following website at <a href="www.dlgsc.wa.gov.au">www.dlgsc.wa.gov.au</a>. Details of completion must be provided on the nomination form.

Where an agent lodges a nomination on a candidate's behalf, it must be in the prescribed form with a written authorisation signed by the candidate.

The documents may be hand delivered or posted to the Returning Officer and must be received by the close of nominations.

# **Chicken Diane**

- Cut each chicken breast, on an angle, into 4 slices.
- 2) Heat oil and 1/2 the butter in a large frying pan over medium-high heat. Cook chicken for 3 minutes each side or until golden. Transfer to a plate.
- 3) Add remaining butter to pan. Cook for 1 minute or until melted. Add eschalot and garlic. Cook for 2 minutes or until eschalot softens. Carefully add brandy (sauce may flare up at this stage). Cook for 1 minute or until reduced slightly. Stir in mustard, Worcestershire sauce and cream. Bring to a simmer.
- 4) Return chicken to pan. Reduce heat to medium. Simmer, covered, for 4 to 5 minutes or until chicken is cooked through. Sprinkle with chives. Serve with broccolini and mash.

- 1. 3 small chicken breast fillets
- 2. 2 tsp extra virgin olive oil
- 3. 40g butter
- 4. 2 eschalots, sliced
- 5. 2 garlic cloves, crushed
- 6. 1/2 cup brandy
- 7. 3 tsp Dijon mustard
- 8. 2 tbsp Worcestershire sauce
- 9. 3/4 cup Bulla Cooking Cream
- 10. 1 tbsp chopped fresh chives
- 11. 1 bunch broccolini, steamed
- 12. Mashed potato, to serve
