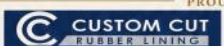

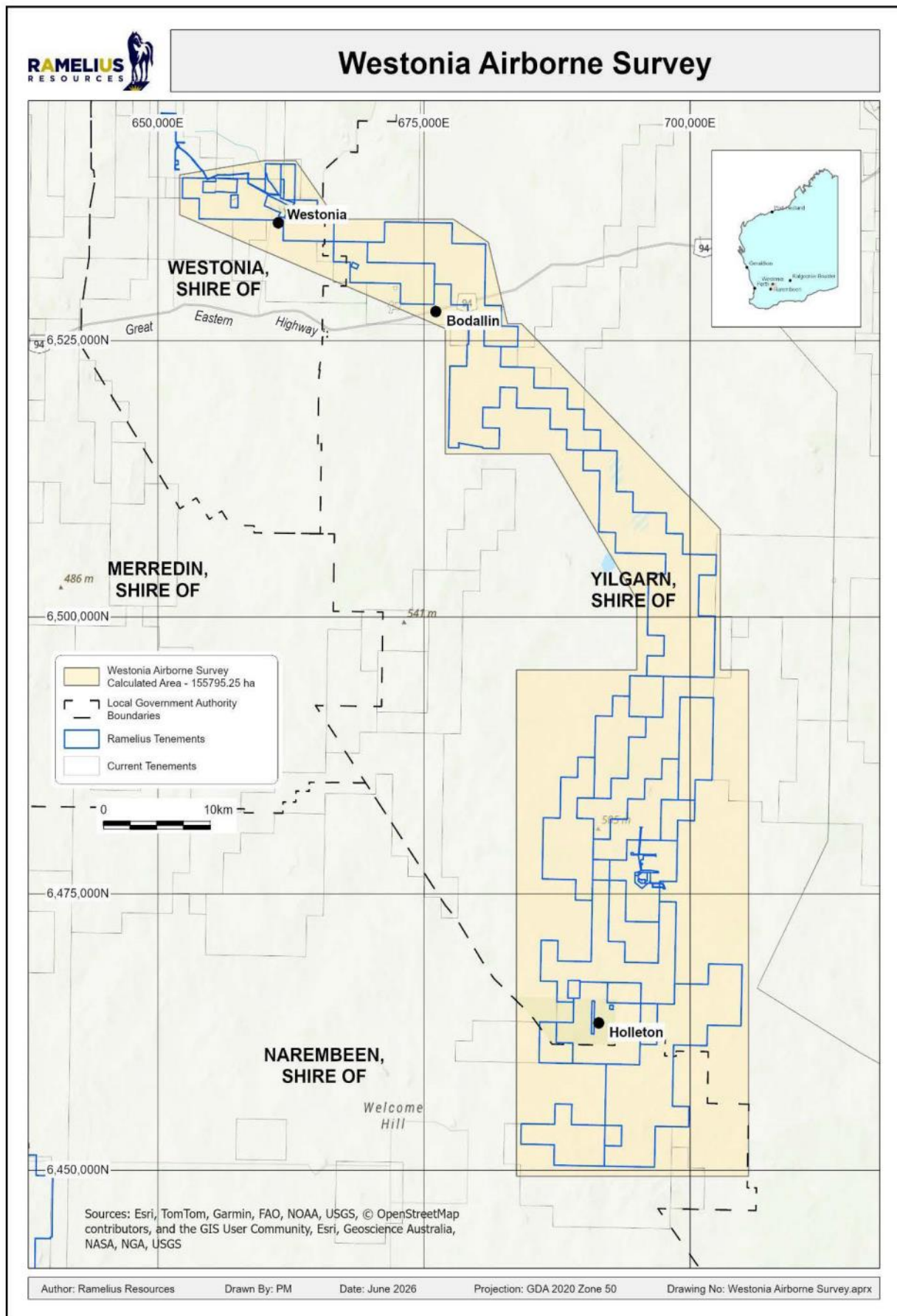
Ramelius Resources Ltd has contracted MAGSPEC Airborne Surveys Pty Ltd to conduct an airborne LOW-LEVEL SURVEY over the area shown on the map below. The survey will improve geological mapping and targeting within Ramelius' tenement area.

Commencing mid-July, the survey will be flown with a single piston-engine Cessna 210 or 206 aircraft, based out of Southern Cross. The aircraft will fly at a height of approximately 30m above ground, running North South with line spacing of 40m. Tie lines will be recorded in an East West direction 400m spacing. The aircraft will fly higher over dwellings.

This survey uses passive instruments to receive and record data only, there are no cameras on board.
